Dear Members,

We are traveling through uncharted waters and it seems that circumstances are changing very quickly. As we continue to comply with state mandated directives, we are doing our best to serve our members, employees, and our community, while keeping the safety of all as a top priority.

The announcement by the CDC to plan for an 8-week ban on gatherings of more than 50 people, and Governor DeWine's announcement that all restaurants and bars must close, we've made the following changes to our operations:

- ➔ **The restaurant will operate offering a takeout menu via curbside service during lunch hours, 11:00 am – 2:30 pm, Tuesday through Friday and Sunday. Orders can be placed by calling 440-235-2646. A menu will be posted on our website. We will accept cash or credit cards. Customers will be able to pull up near the kitchen entrance and food will be brought to the car. Signage will make the pick-up location easy to find.**
- ➔ Dining in the restaurant/bar is banned and it is closed until further notice.
- ➔ All daytime, evening and weekend group or individual activities are canceled until further notice. This includes all scheduled meetings, practices, and group activities. Any questions can be directed to the office staff during regular business hours. Any resumption of activities will need to be cleared with the Executive Board and the Office once this crisis is over.

The building will only be open to a limited number of employees during regular business hours between 9 am and 5 pm, and they can be contacted by calling 440-235-2646. Please do not visit in person. Currently, we do not have any staff members who have taken ill, and we will continue to monitor the health and safety of our employees.

Please look for further information on our website, through e-blasts and email, and through social media platforms in order to stay informed. We will alert membership to any changes as we continue to monitor this ever-changing situation. We need to come together as a community and support each other at this difficult time so that we can all, eventually, resume our usual activities at Lenau Park.
