Event Coordinator - This position handles Marketing and Sales of our rentable spaces as well as works with the client to plan all of the details of their event. 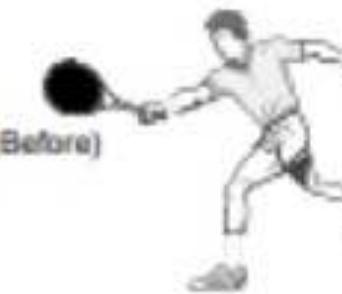

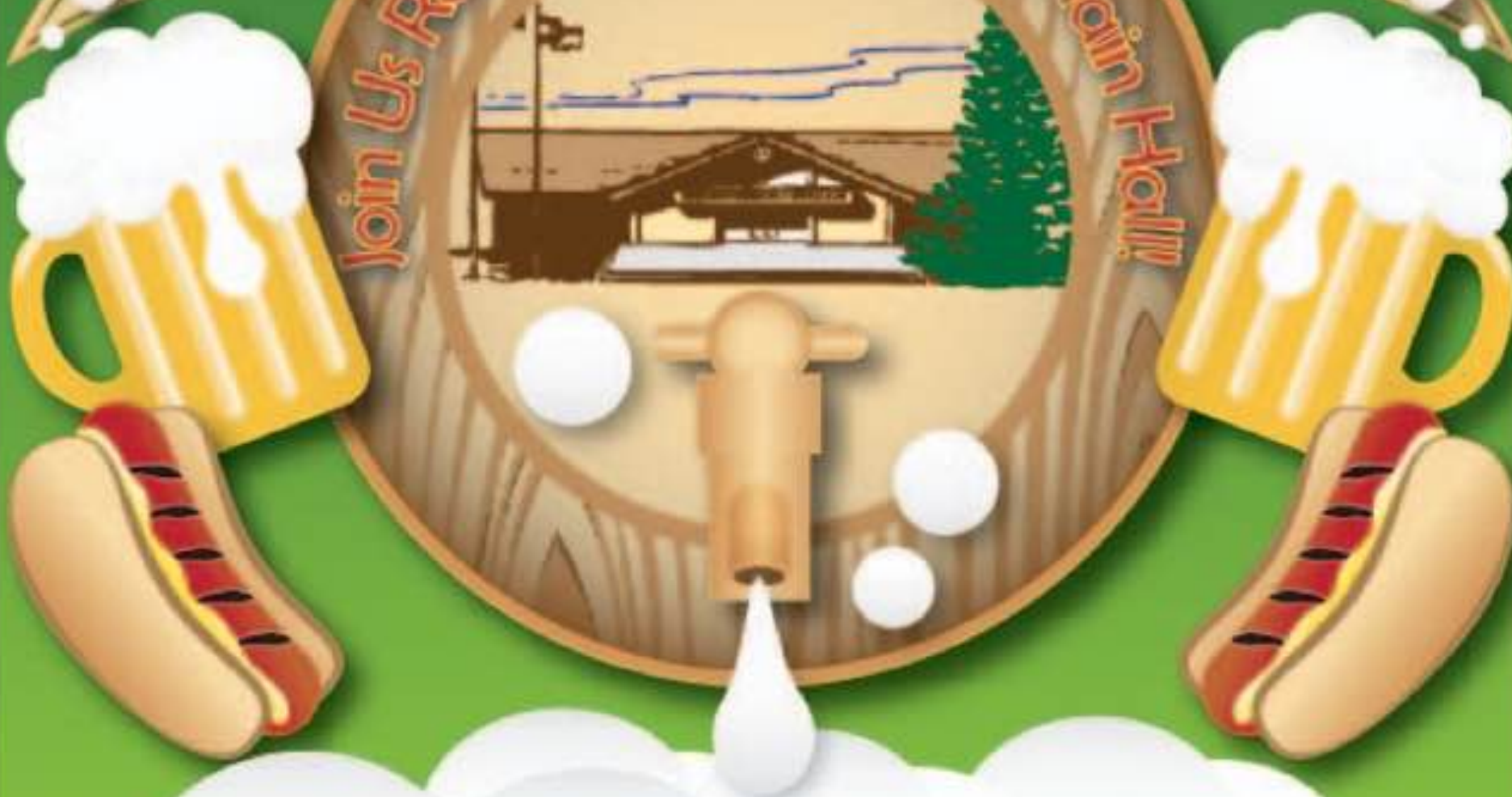
