National Championship qualifiers receive a weekend in New York City (Sept. 15-17) including airfare for the winner, hotel, and VIP treatment. The US CHAMPION will qualify in NYC and receive a trip for two to Munich - not for Oktoberfest (dates TBD)

Program after meeting:

In addition to sharing some personal family stories and seeing where they connect to the history we all learn at school, Astrid Julian will show you some tips and tricks to using your cellphone to find where past generations of Germans, played, studied and worked. A handout will be available for you to guide your own tour of Cleveland's many Germans.

Astrid Julian



Astrid Julian lives on the shore of Lake Erie in Lorain, Ohio. Her fiction has been published in the US, the UK, Canada, German, China and Russia. Her novella, "Irene's Song" tells the story of a German-Canadian composer whose magical music steals children killed during war back from the angels and returns them to their parents. It was short-listed for the British Science Fiction Award when it first appeared in print in the UK and has been reprinted in Germany.

Astrid is a German native who grew up in the US and Canada. She taught German at the Cleveland German Language School in Olmsted Falls, Ohio, and wrote and directed German language plays for children to perform on such topics as the Brothers Grimm, German Reunification, German inventors and explorers, a Donauschwaben village wedding celebration, German composers and legends, and many other aspects of German culture. She has attended German government-sponsored teacher-training seminars in Berlin, Cologne, Leipzig, Dresden and Weimar.

Currently, Astrid works as an Instructional Designer at the NASA Safety Center developing Training and Professional Development courses and materials for NASA personnel. Her nonfiction video scripts number in the hundreds. A small sampling appears on YouTube. She has written three history of Cleveland videos... "Cleveland's Economic History", "Cleveland's Women" and "African-Americans in Cleveland." Most of her videos, however, describe NASA science and engineering projects. They include space-based microscopy on the International Space Station, the testing of rockets in NASA wind tunnels and vacuum chambers at NASA Glenn and Plum Brook Station (now Neil Armstrong Test Facility) in Sandusky, a pilot training aid for the FAA, NASA and the NTSB, and "Return to Flight", the story of how NASA Glenn scientists and engineers helped to return the shuttle to flight status after the crash of the Columbia.
